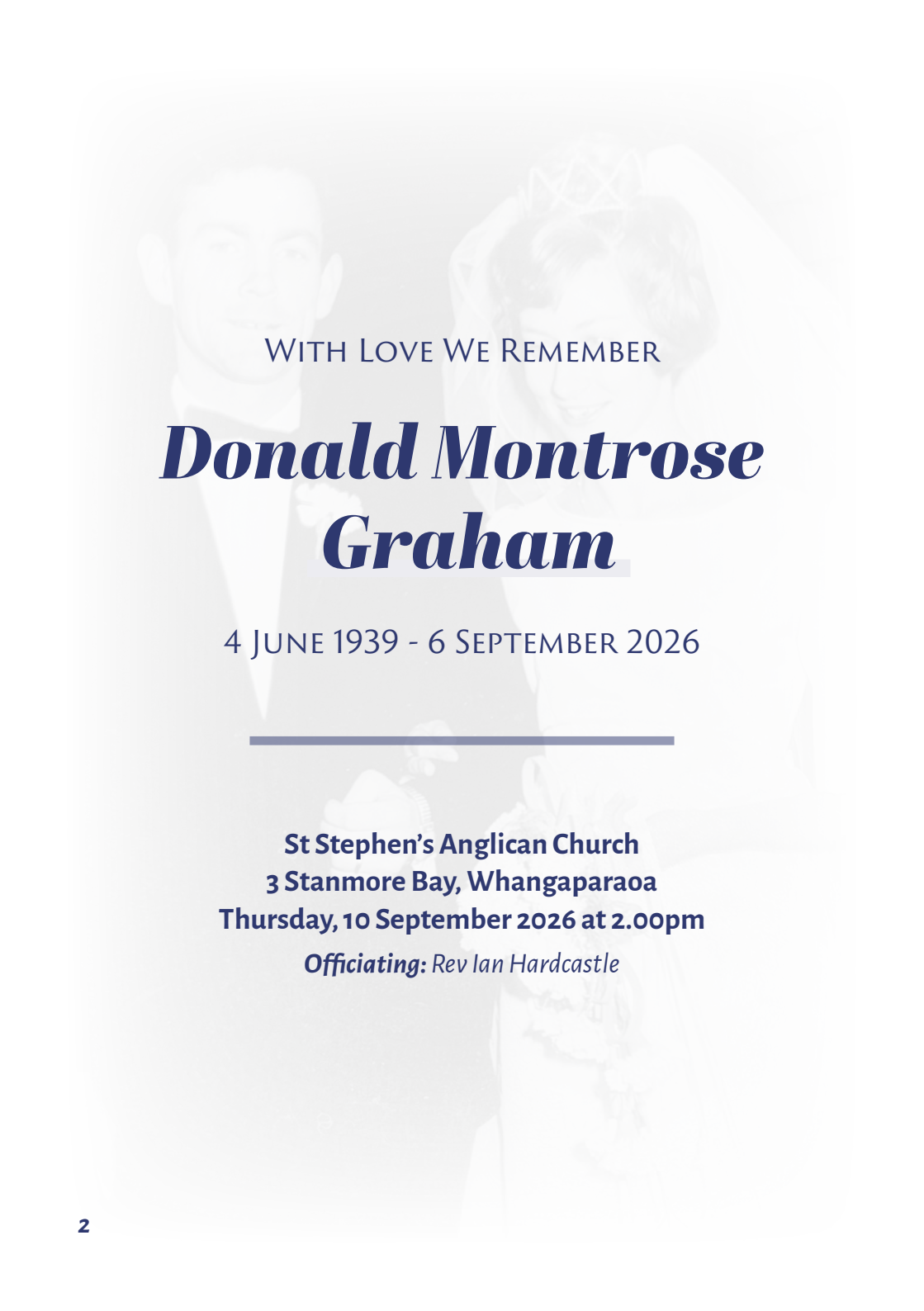

anyone who believes in me, will live.

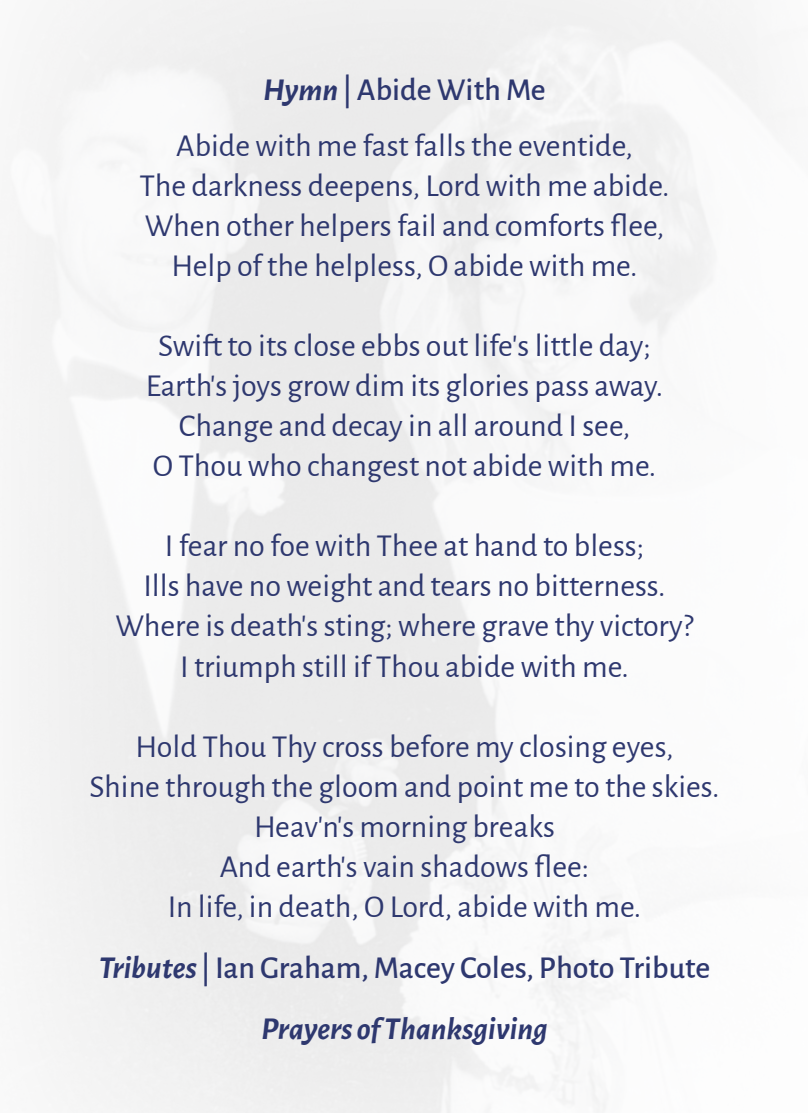

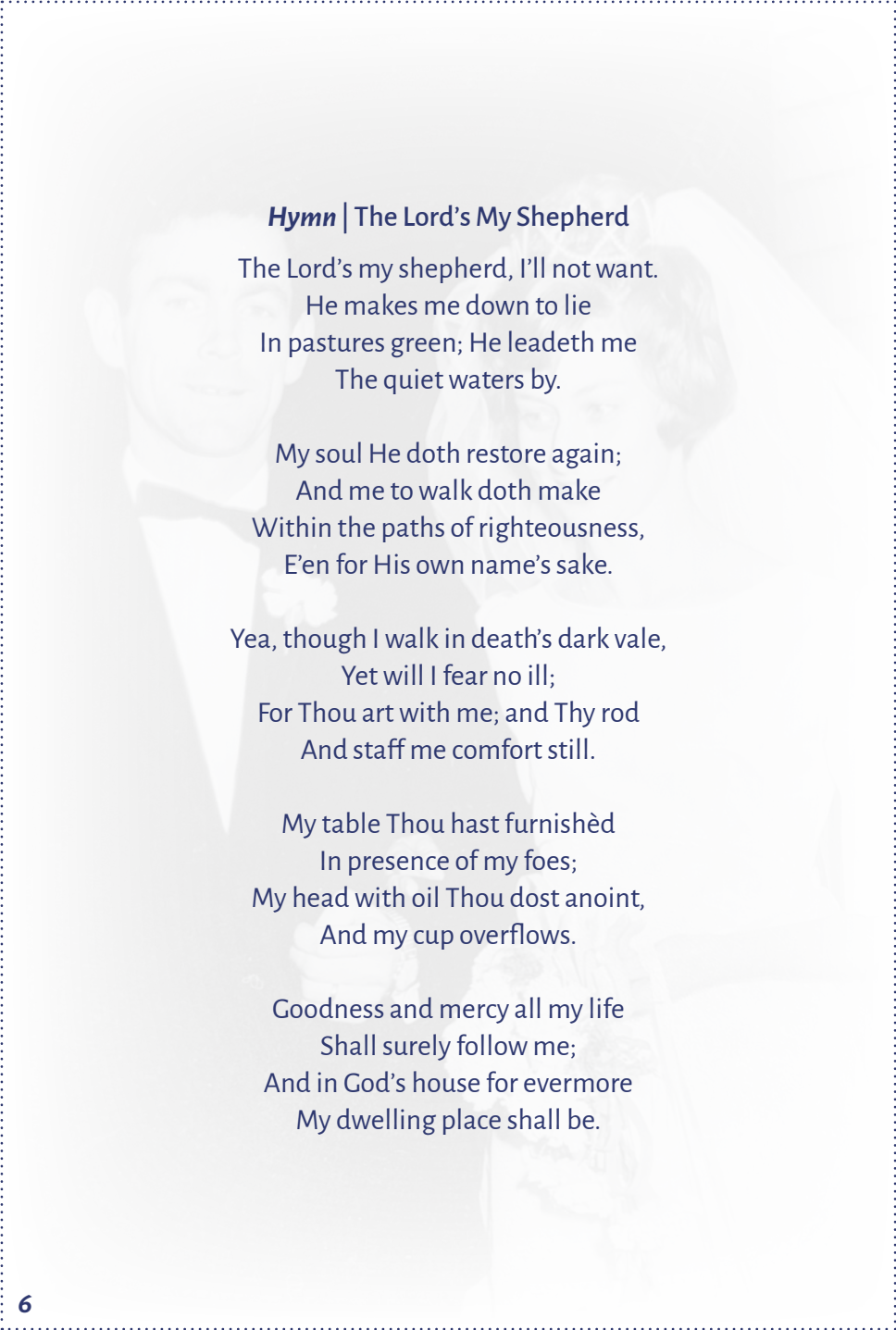
We thank you that Christ facing death on the cross gives us courage;
